



Home-Learning Ideas – 1 Theme: Rainbows LKS2 (Y3/4)

Other interesting facts</p> <p>Make an information leaflet about leprechauns</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Art</p> <p>A lot of children around the country are drawing and colouring rainbows and sticking them in windows to cheer people up.
